This week our Year 3 and 5 students are participating in the National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) to assess their literacy and numeracy skills.

The results of the test will provide important information about what each child can do, and will be used to support teaching and learning programs. It must be kept in mind that a range of assessment tests / tools are used by schools throughout the school year to assess student learning outcomes; NAPLAN is one such test.

All volunteers will need to complete the **Undertaking for Volunteers' Form and Training Module** online before they can volunteer at St John's, please use the link below.

Step 1: Complete 'Building Child Safe Communities - Undertaking for Volunteers' Form

You will need to complete a Volunteers Form for **each location** that you volunteer. A notification of your successful completion of the form will be sent via e-mail to the volunteering location and also to your email address.

Step 2: Complete the online training module

It is a system requirement that the online training module be completed by all volunteers commencing at any of our locations and the training needs to be completed every second year.

- Open the module by clicking the **Start** link below.
- Read through the presentation.

Complete and submit quiz questions (this will take approximately 10 minutes).

NOTE: IF YOU HAVE ALREADY COMPLETED THE TRAINING MODULE YOU WILL ONLY NEED TO COMPLETE THE UNDERTAKING FOR VOLUNTEERS' FORM.
