Due to the ongoing COVID 19 situation a significant number of our usual yearly school and diocesan events / activities have been either cancelled or postponed. Through this period of disruption to our yearly school plan we have been challenged to adapt and find different ways of 'doing things', that is implementing activities in a COVID safe environment. Below is a list of events / learning experiences that have been organised to date:

ES1 Teddy Bear's Picnic

Last Friday our ESI had a **'Teddy Bear's Picnic'** to celebrate 'Ted's' birthday. This event gave the children the opportunity to participate in a shared celebration. Our little ones enjoyed being outdoors in the sunshine and showing off their teddy's with their friends.

In this time they have formed relationships, learnt about the routines of the classroom and the school community; have enthusiastically engaged in their learning. 
Sacramental Program - First Eucharist


