Intensive Swimming Program

As previously advised I investigated the possibility of implementing the two week intensive swimming program at Coulter Swimming Centre. However, after consulting with the manager of the swimming centre and with further discussion with the leadership team a decision has been made not to proceed with the swimming program this year.


This decision was based on a number of factors:

- 1) we would be required to move St John's swimming program to an afternoon timeslot as the morning timeslots have been designated to the centres swimming classes
 - 2) contact with the general public could not be avoided
 - 3) access to bathroom facilities for our children would be problematic
 - 4) risk of contact with 'gym members' who attend the gym facility within the complex and
 - 5) concerns of travelling by bus have been raised with me.

The safety of our students and staff is always our top priority therefore; we will not proceed.

Staff Development Day

Last Monday the teachers at St John's participated in professional development to gain a deeper understanding of the new Religious Education Curriculum. The Religious Education Curriculum is still at the draft stage. Our teachers have been working alongside our Religious Education Coordinator, Mrs Roffmann in developing 'cycles of learning' (units of work) for each stage to be implemented this term.

- To represent the school at community functions

Student Leaders will be identified through a selection and voting process. The successful applicants will be introduced before the end of the term and will be inducted into their student leadership positions at the commencement of 2021.

COVID-19 Testing

Currently, no student should attend school if they are unwell. Each student who is absent from school or who has been sent home because they have flu-like symptoms

must have a COVID-19 test

- Students are not able to return to school <u>until they return a negative</u>

 <u>COVID-19 result and are symptom free</u>
- A negative COVID-19 test result must be provided to the school before a student can come back to school. The test results can be a NSW Health or COVID-19 Testing Centre letter, SMS or email and/or a medical certificate.
 - These same protocols apply to school staff

Managing COVID-19 is a complex issue. At St John's (as elsewhere) our primary goal is the well-being of our students, families and staff. With this in mind we will continue to implement practices and protocols advocated by NSW Health and the Catholic Education Department. When there is a change to advice from Health professionals and the CEDP we will inform our community immediately. Thank you for your continued support in this matter.

Last week (normally August) a winner for each category was selected.


