#### **Season of Advent**

The Season of advent begins on Sunday 29th November. Advent is a time where we prepare ourselves for the birth of Jesus. We are waiting like the Shepherds and the Wise Men for the promised one.

At Advent we place our advent wreath on our Sacred spaces in our learning spaces. The wreath is a circle which means that it never ends. The green - means evergreen and new life. We also have four candles on the wreath which symbolise the four weeks of advent. Each candle and week has a special significance this being:

- The 1st Sunday of Advent symbolizes Hope with the "Prophet's Candle" reminding us that Jesus is coming. (Purple Candle)
  - The 2nd Sunday of Advent symbolizes Faith with the "Bethlehem Candle" reminding us of Mary and Joseph's journey to

Bethlehem. (Purple Candle)

- The 3rd Sunday of Advent symbolizes Joy with the "Shepherd's Candle" reminding us of the Joy the world experienced at the coming birth of Jesus. (Pink Candle)
- The 4th Sunday of Advent symbolizes Peace with the "Angel's Candle" reminding us of the message of the angels: "Peace on
  Earth, Good Will Toward Men." (Purple Candle)



The white candle is lit on Christmas Day to symbolise Jesus' birth.
