What will my child learn at school?

At St John's the curriculum consists of Key Learning Areas including Religious Education. NSW Education Standards Authority - NESA sets the learning requirements for each stage of primary school. Kindergarten to Year 6 includes four Stages of learning:

Kindergarten	Years 1 and 2	Years 3 and 4	Years 5 and 6
EARLY STAGE 1	STAGE 1	STAGE 2	STAGE 3

Key Learning Areas (KLAs) describe broad areas of learning. In Kindergarten to Year 6, Catholic schools are required to have educational programs for the following key learning areas:

Religious Education English - (literacy) Mathematics- (numeracy) Science and Technology Human Society and its Environment (HSIE)-History and Geography Creative Arts - (Visual Arts, Dance, Music and Drama) Personal Development, Health and Physical Education-

(Gymnastics / Dance Fever (alternate years); swimming program - Term 4; swimming and athletics Carnivals; Other Sports Gala days may include: Touch Football, Netball, Basketball and Soccer.
