Attendance

Throughout most of the first half of the year our overall attendance rate has been close to 90 percent and while this may sound high we are always aiming to have attendance rates above 95 percent - that is 95 percent of children at school 95 percent of the time.

We understand that we ask you to keep children at home if they are unwell and that children have had to isolate due to family illness. However, if children are well and can be at school then they should be at school. Please consider your reasons for keeping children at home. It is easy to fall into a pattern of non attendance when children are allowed to stay home regularly when they are not sick.

Every day missed makes it harder for children to catch up and can lead to gaps in learning and social connections. Two days off a term adds up to four weeks a year, which over the the course of schooling from Kindergarten to Year 12 adds up to a full year missed.

Work Health and Safety Reminders

Kiss and Drop Safety

A reminder that where possible children should be exiting the car via the driver's side and stepping into the yellow zone once they are safely out of the car and have closed the door. We are encouraging all children to close their own car door - please practise with your child how to close the car door safely.

If your child needs to exit from the passenger side they must walk to the front of your vehicle and cross in front of you rather than behind where other cars are driving into the Kiss and Drop Zone.

Children must also remain seated and with their seat belt on until you come to a complete stop.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our students and staff safe.

COVID 19 Back to School Safety

A reminder that if your child tests positive to COVID-19, it's important to let the school know as soon as possible and to notify NSW Health through the Service NSW App. For safety, schools will also be monitoring students' health and asking families to collect students who display COVID-19 symptoms. If they display any symptoms they should take a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) or a PCR test. If the test is negative but symptoms continue, your child MUST stay home and take another RAT or PCR test in 24 hours. Please note that if there is a case of COVID-19 in your child's class, year or other grouping, your child can continue to attend school if they have no symptoms, in line with NSW Health advice. Please let the school know of the absence and when it is expected they will be able to return.
